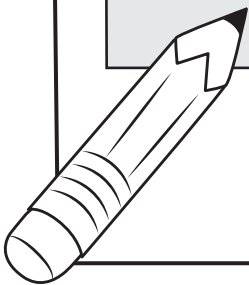
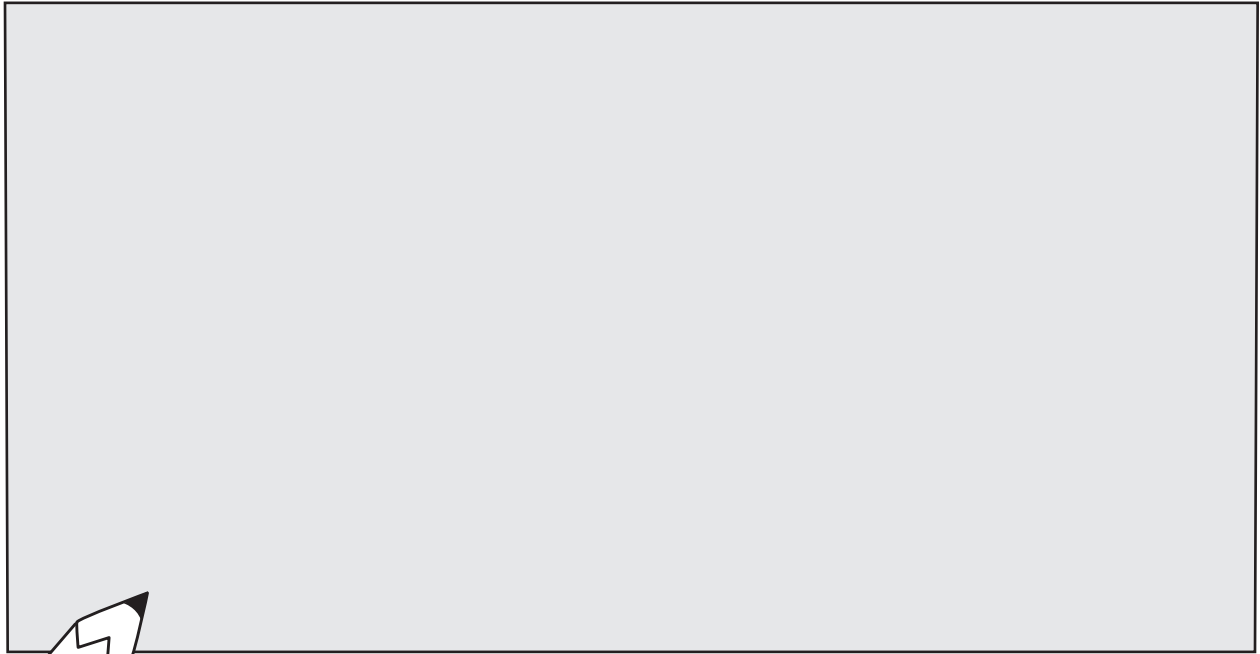
It's important to have a **FLOOD SAFETY KIT**

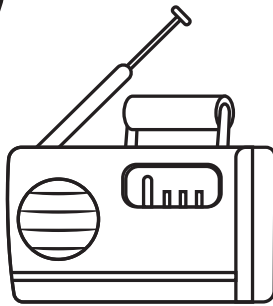

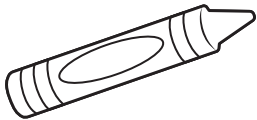
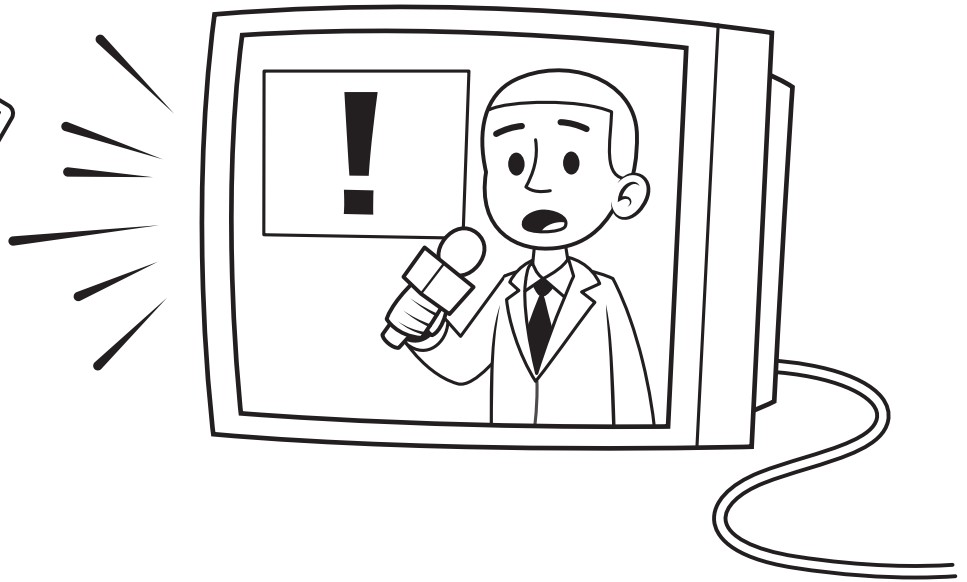
LISTEN FOR FLOOD ALERTS

because they mean different things.

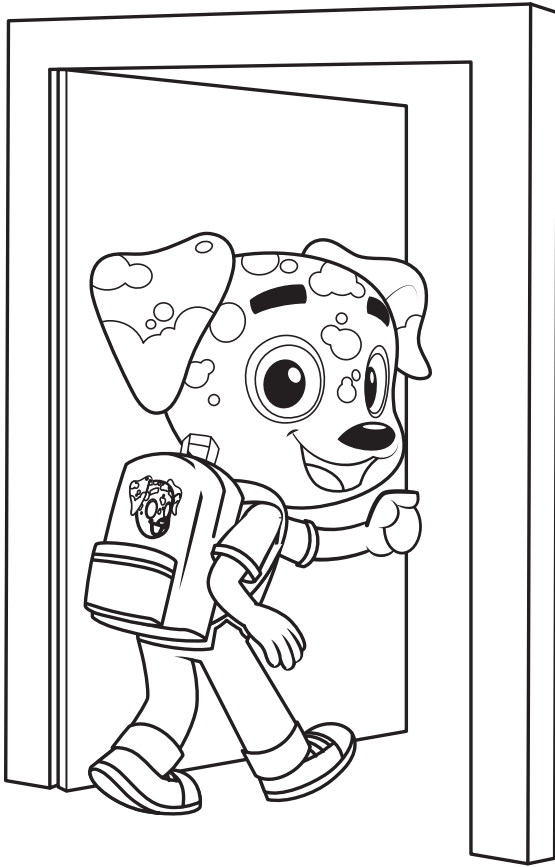


FLOOD WATCH

means that flooding is possible
and to listen to local radio,
TV news or NOAA Weather Radio.



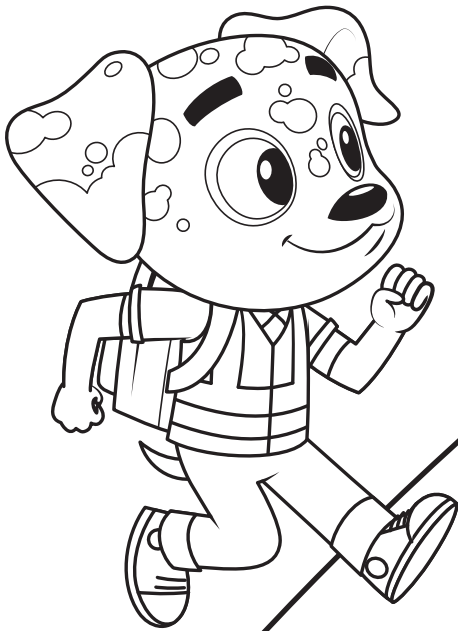

FLOOD WARNING

means that a flood is happening.

If you and your family live in a flood-prone zone, you should follow your Family Flood Safety Plan immediately.



FLASH FLOOD WARNING

means go to higher ground immediately.

GETTING TO SAFETY

In a flood, you may have to evacuate.
Help Rocket follow a safe route to higher ground.
Some roads might be blocked by obstacles!

KNOW YOUR SAFE ZONES

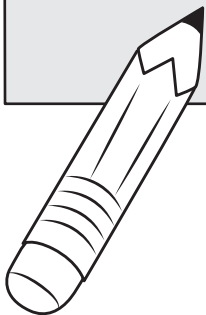
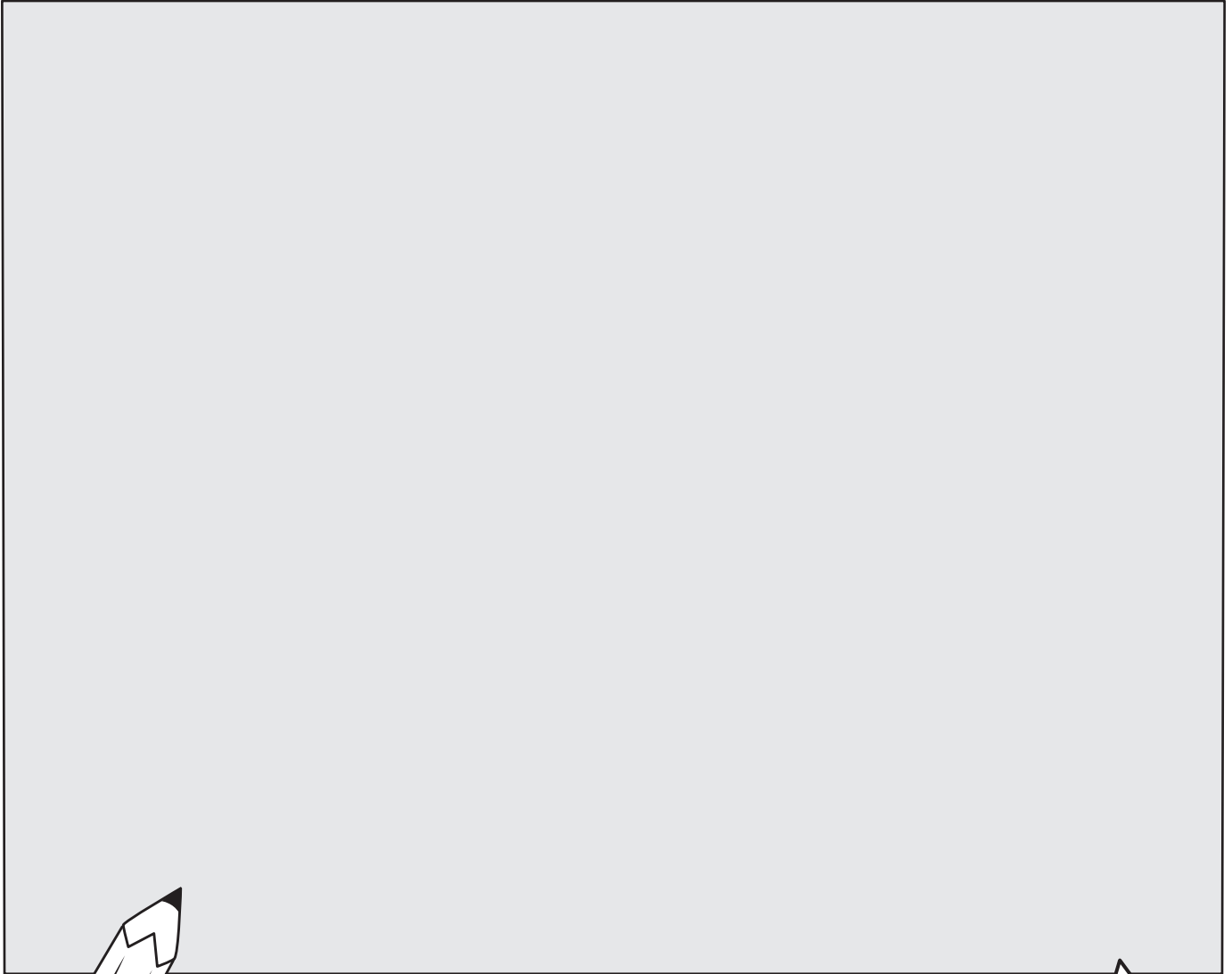
With a flood, even a few inches of fastmoving water can sweep you away.
The higher up you are, the safer you'll be. In some of these images, Rocket is doing the right thing and has found his Safe Zone. In others, he's not.

you can make better decisions.



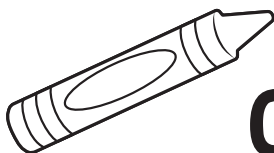

CALL FOR HELP

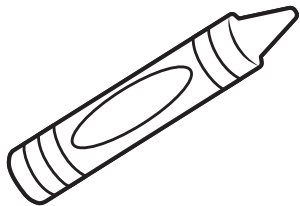
In a flood, sometimes phones don't work.

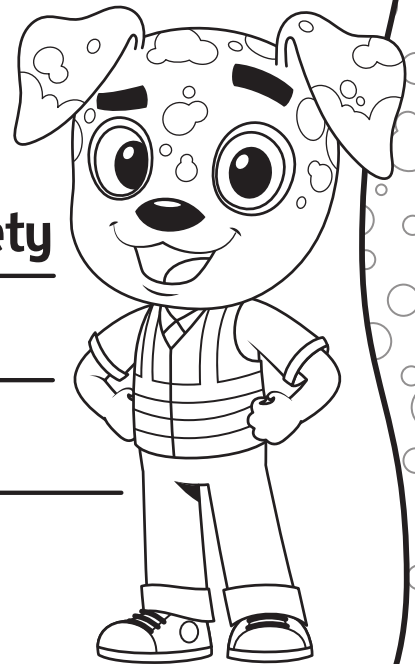

FLOOD SAFETY CHECKLIST

- ☐ Have a **FLOOD SAFETY KIT** packed and ready to go for your family and pets.
- ☐ Know your **EMERGENCY CONTACTS'** phone numbers.
- ☐ **LISTEN TO WEATHER ALERTS** on the local radio, TV, or NOAA Weather Station.
- ☐ **FOLLOW DIRECTIONS** from the Weather Service and First Responders.
- ☐ Have and practice an **EVACUATION PLAN** with routes to your Safe Zone.

☐ **DON'T** drink or walk through flood water!

☐ **STAY CALM.**
