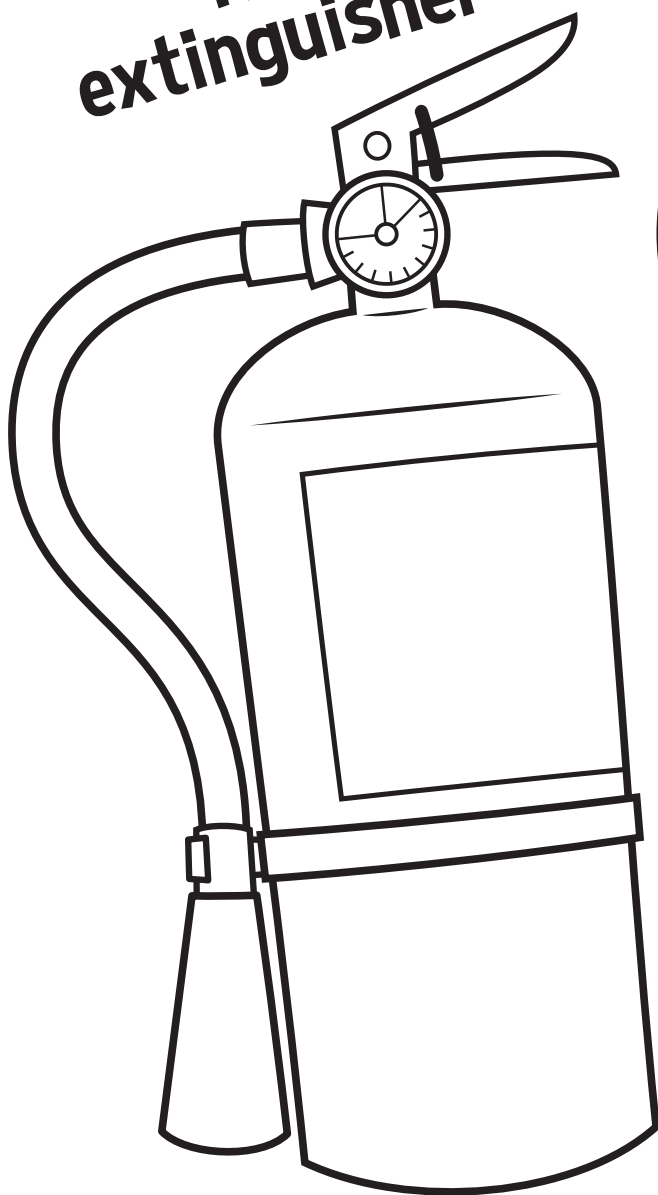
**Fires can be dangerous.

and that they're working properly.

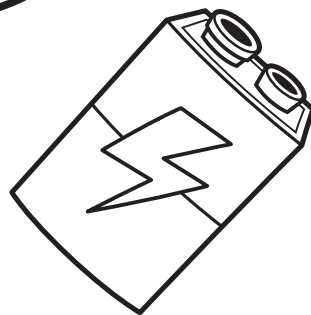
**fire

batteries

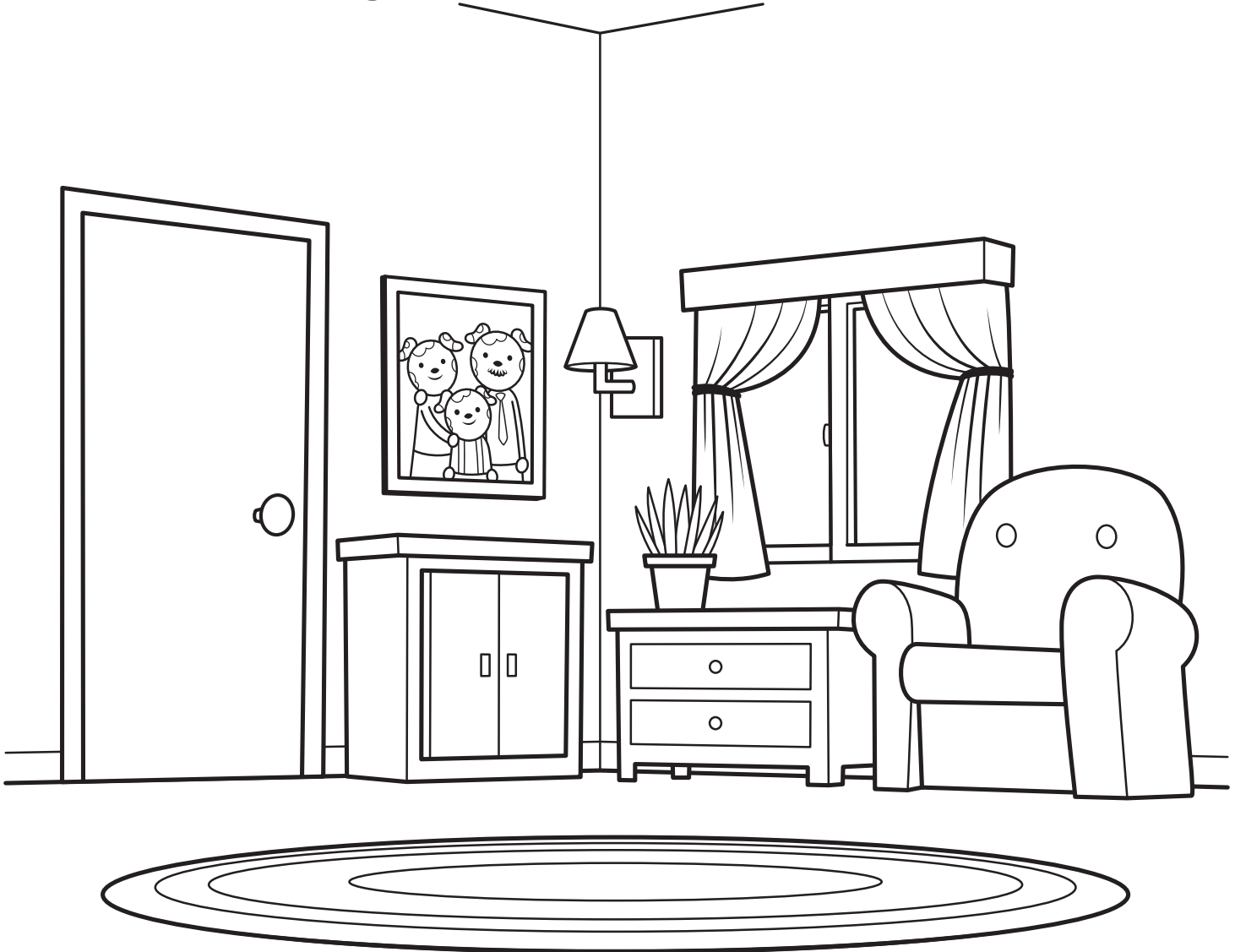


flashlight

FIND YOUR WAYS OUT

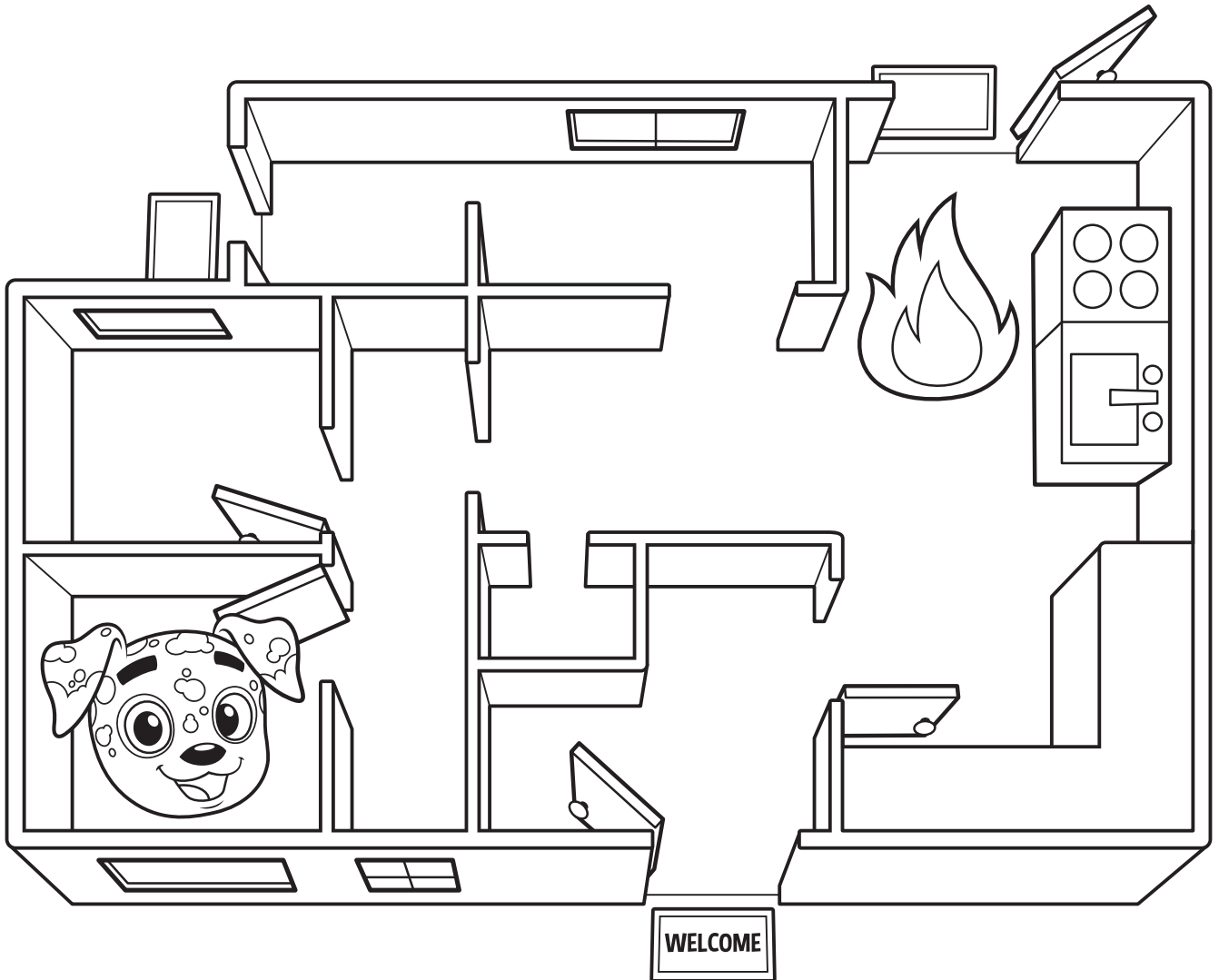
Always have at least two ways out.

Once you're there, wait until help arrives.**

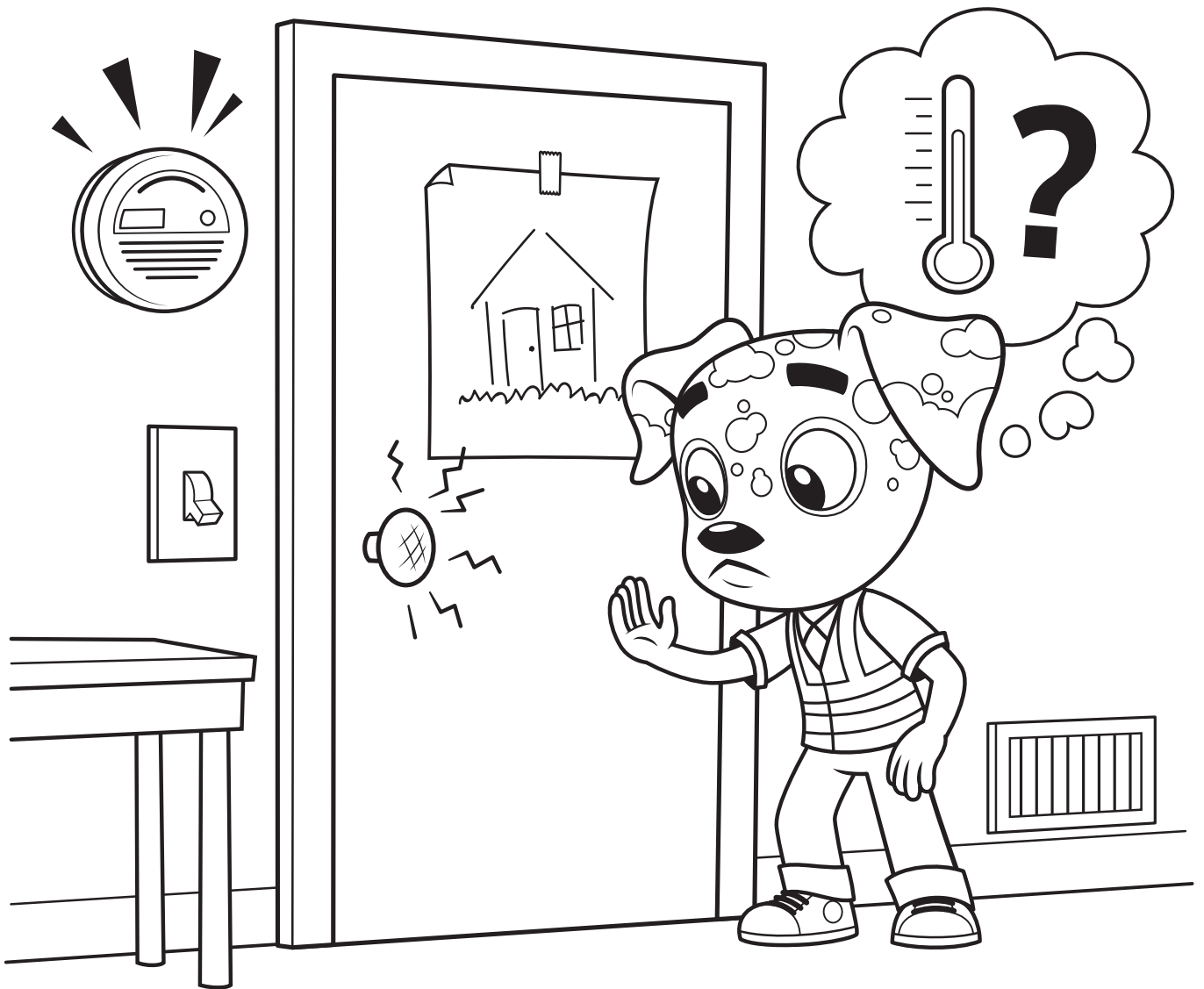


**Can you draw a line showing

IS IT HOT?

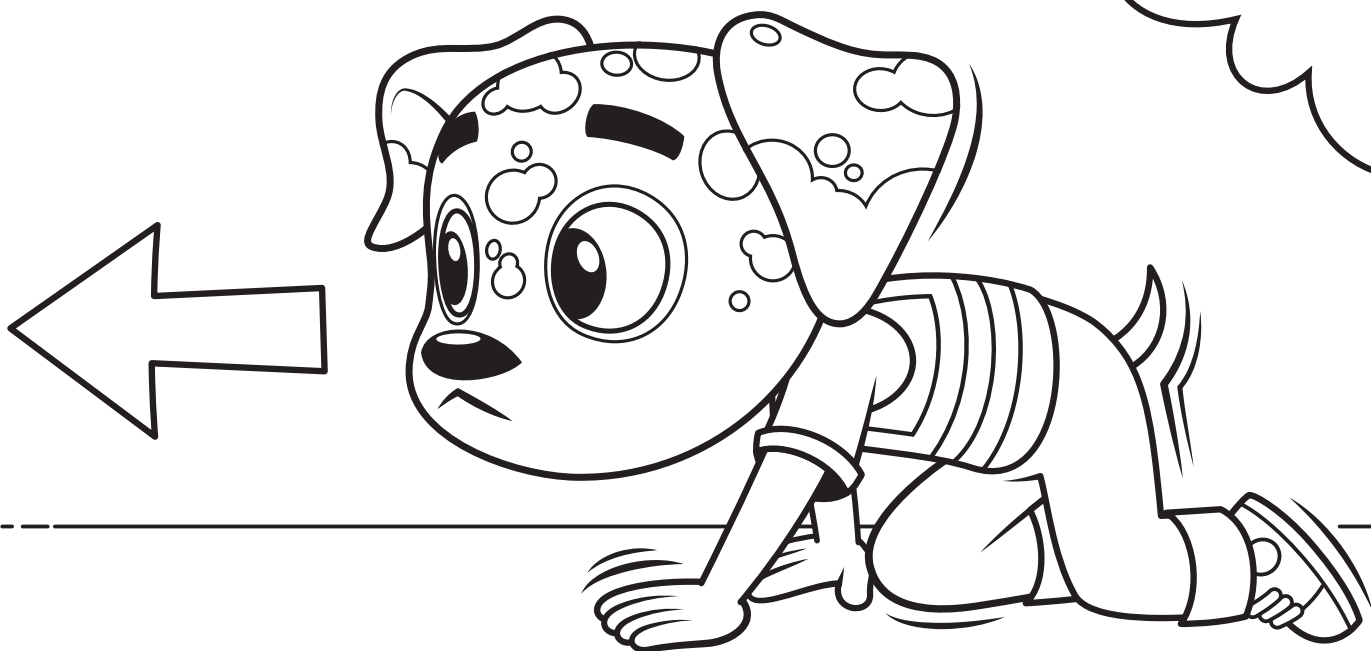
**Always remember to check the door

crawl to a safe exit.**



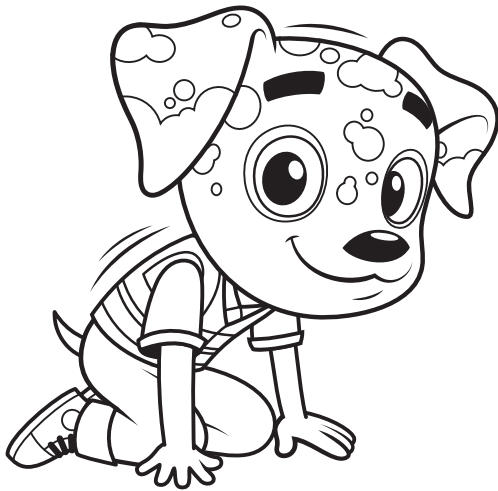
Follow the plan to your Safe Zone!

catch on fire,**

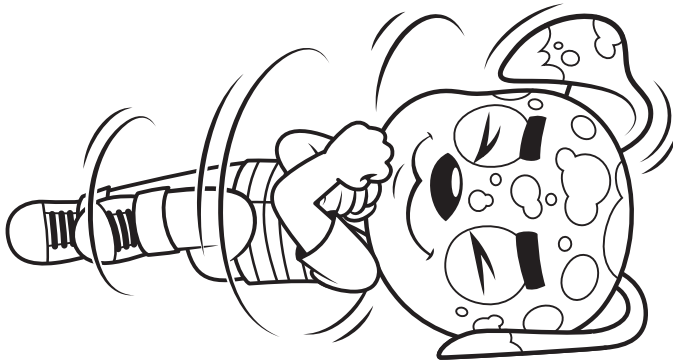
STOP

to the ground,



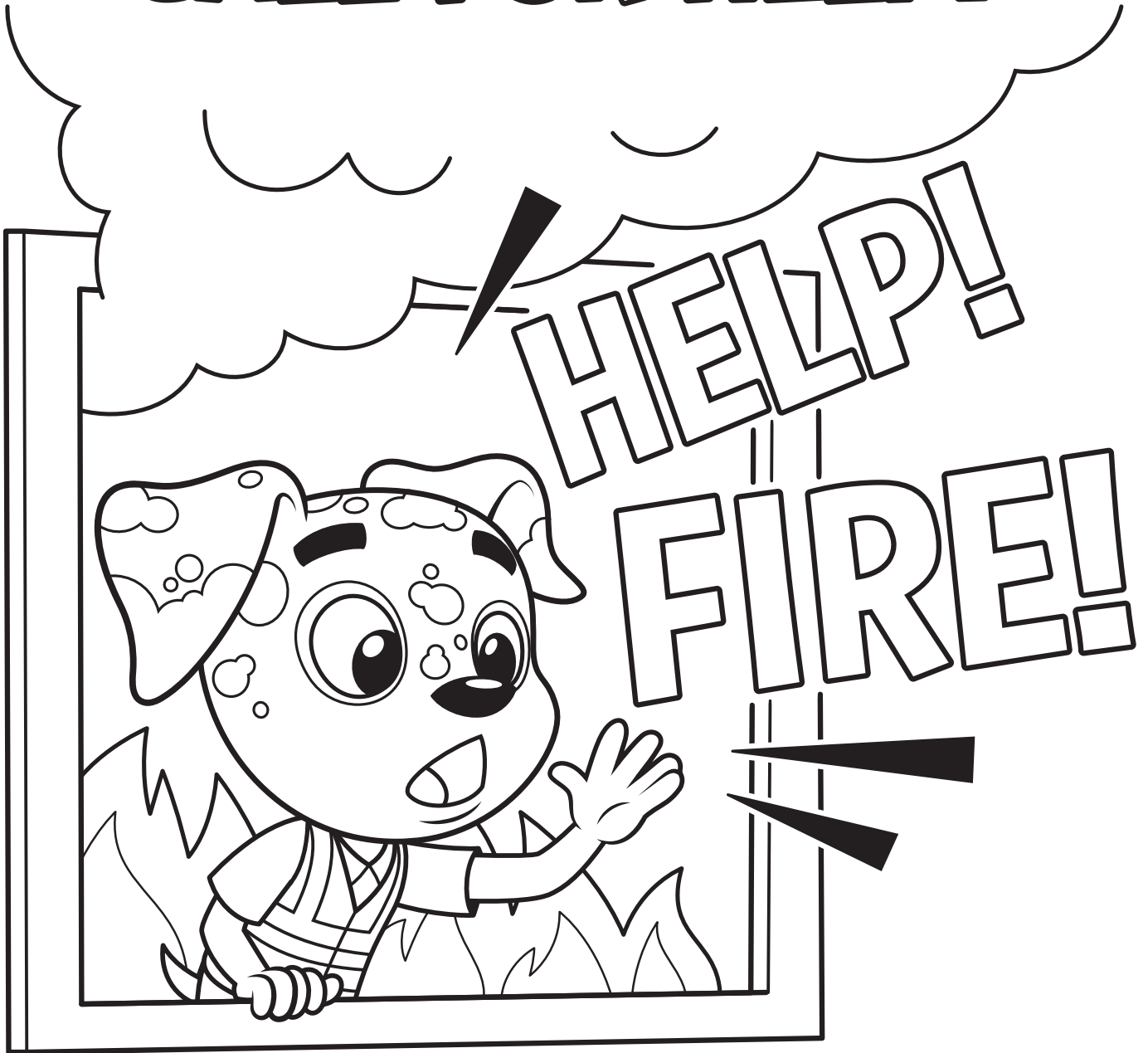
and

ROLL

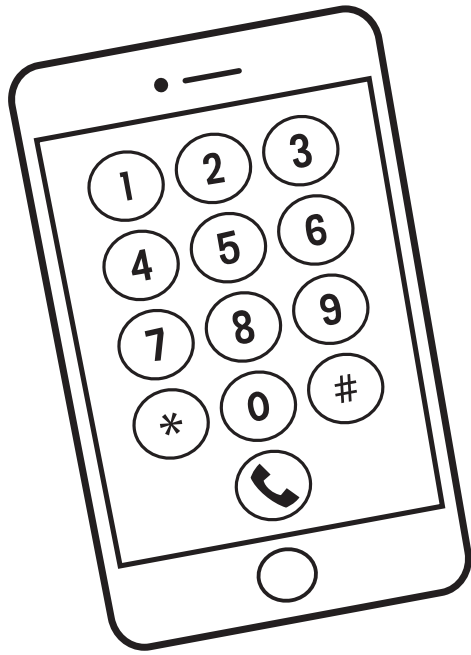
to put out the fire.

CALL FOR HELP!



**If there's a fire and you can't get out,
open a window and yell "HELP! FIRE!"
as loudly as you can.**



DIAL 9-1-1

Call **911**
once you're out
and safe.

**Remember, the person on the other
end of the phone is your friend!**



**Wait for a firefighter or a first
responder to come and get you.**

Rocket's 5 RULES OF FIRE SAFETY



1. **BE PREPARED**

Check your smoke alarms once a month.



2. **STAY CALM**

A calm mind makes better decisions.



3. **FOLLOW THE PLAN**

Don't hide - go outside! Always have at least two ways out.



4. **STAY IN YOUR SAFE ZONE**

Go to your meeting place and wait there until help arrives.



5. **CALL FOR HELP**

Once you're out safely, call 9-1-1 to reach the Fire Department.
