Mental Health experts have expressed their great concern that the Covid pandemic, during the past year plus, has had a devastating effect on the well-being of young children.

The Finding Feelings Activity Book, Rocket animated videos, officer scripts and teacher lessons will be available to all schools in October.

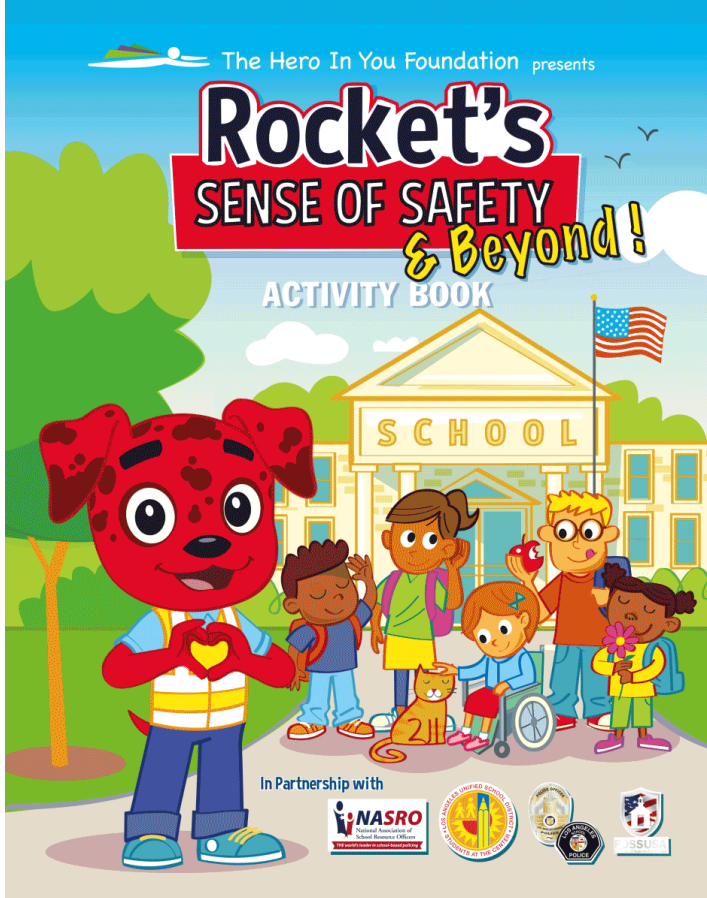
ROCKET IS A BIG HIT AT LAPD RAMPART FAMILY COMMUNITY EVENT
