


A flood happens when there's a lot of water with nowhere to go, and it ends up in places it's not supposed to be. Floods can be dangerous, so it's important to be prepared.

DO YOU HAVE ENOUGH WATER?


Make sure you have at least one gallon of bottled water for every person in your family for at least 3 days.



FLASH FLOOD WARNING


means go to higher ground immediately.

MOW YOUR SAFE ZON



Floods can be scary. But when you're calm, you can make better decisions.




Thinking of happy things can help you stay calm.
