Script

Who likes playing video games? What games do you play? (Pause for responses). Wow, there are a lot of different games! Do any of you chat with your friends on your video games? What about chatting through apps? What are your favorite apps to keep in touch with friends? (Discuss). When we are online, it is important to remember that we are connected to people all over the world! Because the online world connects us, we need to be safe on all our devices. Who can name some devices we use to get online to play games? (cell phone, tablet, computer, xbox).

Great!

We know we should never talk to strangers. You would never get in a car with a stranger or take candy from them because that could be dangerous. It could also be dangerous to talk to strangers online.

The same way we lock our doors at home to keep strangers and intruders out, we need to lock and block strangers from our devices. Sometimes people pretend to be someone else when they are chatting with you online.

They may do this steal your personal information, or try to harm you. If anyone tries to do this, block them immediately, and tell a trusted adult. You should never give personal information (like photos or addresses) to anyone you don't know.

Locking and blocking is one way to stay safe on line. Now we're going to watch Rocket's video to learn other ways to stay safe on line: this is called Cybersecurity.
